Homeowners can get up to \$1,500 in tax credits for all energy-efficient home improvements.

For Mitsubishi Electric split-ductless cooling and heating systems, this could mean 30 percent of the total cost of heat pump installation including equipment, materials and labor. The tax credit was effective February 17, 2009 after President Obama signed the new American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA; also known as the Stimulus Bill).

TO QUALIFY

HVAC systems must be installed after February 17, 2009 through the end of 2010. Split-system heat pumps chosen for installation must achieve the highest CEE Tier Level of energy efficiency; specifications shown below:

- CEE Level:** Tier 2
- SEER:** 15 or higher
- EER:** 12.5 or higher
- HSPF:** 8.5 or higher

QUALIFYING SYSTEMS

Mitsubishi currently has two systems that meet the requirements for the Stimulus Tax Credit. Both the MSZ/MUZ-FD09NA and the MSZ/MUZ-FD12NA systems not only provide the necessary SEER/EER ratings and cooling and heating capacities, but they provide cutting-edge technology that detects hot and cold spots within the room, and include a triple filtration system.
